



## Mr. Edward Price Horton

October 1, 1932 - November 27, 2017

Mr. Edward Price Horton, a resident of Tullahoma, Tennessee passed away at Tennova-Harton Medical Center in Tullahoma on November 27, 2017 at the age of 85.

Mr. Horton was born in Moore County, Tennessee to the late Edward Garrett and Annie Lee Price Horton on October 1, 1932. He was also preceded in death by his first wife Bettye Robertson Horton, a son Edward Earl Horton and his grandson Lee Bartlett Hart.

Known by his family and friends as "Price," he was retired from the United States Air Force after a 29 year career.
