



## James Wallace Brazier

May 14, 1928 - January 16, 2020

James Wallace (PeeWee) Brazier passed away peacefully on January 16, 2020 while at NHC in Tullahoma, TN. He was over 91 years old, having been born in Franklin County, Tennessee on May 14, 1928. Wallace was a member of the First United Methodist Church in Lynchburg.

He was preceded in death by his parents, Thomas Newton and Birdie Lee Hall Brazier; a wife of 49 years, Emma Ophelia (Frame) Brazier; brothers, Thomas (Charlene), Lee Roy (Opal), and Glendon (Maybell) Brazier; sister, Bonnie Mae (Thomas) Brown; and son, James Donald (stillborn).

He is survived by a wife of 19 years, Fran Hubley Brazier. He is, also, survived by a son, Phillip (Kathy) Brazier of Lynchburg; a daughter, Mary Lee (Ronny) Thomas, also of Lynchburg; four grandchildren, Roni (Chris) Carpenter of Madison, AL; Brad (Lindsay) Brazier of Knoxville, TN; Cody Thomas of Lynchburg; Seth (Trista) Thomas of Lynchburg; and six great-grandchildren, all of whom, affectionately, called him "Pa".

Wallace was employed at Genesco Shoe Factory in Tullahoma for 24 years before beginning work at Jack Daniel Distillery, where he retired after 21 years of service.

Wallace loved small game hunting, fishing and vegetable gardening. At one time, he had as many as three different vegetable gardens in Lynchburg from which he shared the produce with any that asked.

He also enjoyed Lynchburg/Moore County high school sports. For many years, he could be found in the stands at all the games, both home and away.

Services will be held at Lynchburg Funeral Home on Saturday, January 18th. Visitation will be from 10:00 AM until 2:00 PM, and funeral services will begin at 2:00 PM. Burial will be at Lois Cemetery.
