Mr. Vernon Lee Farrar passed away at the Lynchburg Nursing Center on September 20, 2017 at the age of 93.

He was born on October 1, 1923 in Moore County, Tennessee to the late Albert and Grace Johnson Farrar. He was also preceded in death by his wife of 64 years Helen McAdams Farrar, brothers John and Bill Farrar and a sister Juanita Coup.

Mr. Farrar was the oldest member of the Hurricane Baptist Church. A veteran of WWII, he served in the Pacific Theatre under the command of Gen. Douglas MacArthur where he received commendations for discovering a mine that could have caused a fatal blow to the ship he was on board. He retired from Jack Daniel Distillery and he also loved to farm.

He is survived by his daughters Betty Preston of Lewisburg, Tennessee; Ellen Ray of Moore County, Tennessee and Sherre Hester and her husband Albert of Bell Buckle, Tennessee.

Surviving grandchildren are Jan Jenkins, John Preston, Rusty Ray and Scott Cook. Also surviving are great grandchildren Caleb Ray, Jacob Cook, Justin Jenkins, Brock, Cody and Sydney Preston.
